CHANI

Meaning "Gibbon" in Thai, Chani's flesh is soft, silky, and smooth, encased in the golden yellow skin. Although lacking in meat, it makes up for its rich fragrance.

KANYAO

Meaning "Long Stalk" in Thai, Kanyao is seen as the most sought-after and competes in the premium durian market. It usually has a long stalk and thick husk, boasting well-balanced flavor that combines sweetness and creaminess.

MONTHONG

Meaning "Golden Pillow" in Thai, Monthong, which has very thick flesh in the mild yellow color with sweet and buttery taste, is Thailand's most exporting variety of durian. The popularity of Monthong means it is renowned around the world and its taste is widely loved by the locals and foreigners. The plantation area is almost in every region of Thailand, especially in the Eastern and Southern part.

Oblong

Thick flesh and Lean seed.

PHUANGMANI

Meaning "bunch of gem stones" in Thai, Phuang Mani is the smallest of the four varieties of durian. With its delicate and sweet flavor, its popularity has been growing continuously.

Elliptic
WEIGHT
Not less than 1 Kg.
AROMA/COLOR
Mild / Dark yellow
TEXTURE
Big seeds. Soft and creamy. Very low in fiber.
TASTE
Rich in flavor. Very Sweet.



THE UNIQUE CHARACTER

Durian is an odd-shaped fruit with a sharp-edged husk. Thanks to its unique aroma and distinctive taste which crowns it as "The King of Tropical Fruits".

PLENTRY OF NUTRIENTS
